The Collect Prayer for the All Saints Days

Almighty God, you have knit together your elect in one communion and fellowship in the mystical body of your Son Christ our Lord: grant us grace so to follow your blessed saints in all virtuous and godly living that we may come to those inexpressible joys that you have prepared for those who truly love you; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen

The Liturgy of Baptism

The introduction explores how baptism is a lifetime decision to walk with Christ in the light of truth.

So I ask the Parents and Godparents these questions...

Q? Do you turn to Jesus Christ? Answer – I turn to Christ. All – Lord, we cannot live without you and we cannot pay for all our wrongdoing. We turn to Christ and ask, Lord have mercy.

Q? Do you repent of your sins? Answer – I repent of my sins. All – Lord, we can say the words but only your life-giving Spirit can truly help us to be sorry for how we have lived. We turn to Christ our Saviour and ask, Christ have mercy.

Q? Do you turn from evil to the life Jesus gives

Answer - I turn to the life only Jesus can give. All – Lord, help us all, from the youngest to the oldest, the lifetime church member to the newest person here, to celebrate being one people in the life Jesus gives. Lord have mercy.

A question for everyone.

To follow Christ is a daily decision. To surrender one's own life, to take up the cross and follow Jesus. Do you affirm your baptism promises?

All – We do! With God's help we shall follow Christ.

Leader – There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism.

All – This is our faith. We believe in One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen!

Signing with a cross

Leader – we must all come to stand at the foot of the cross, Jesus' cross. Here we recognize the true cost of Jesus sacrifice so that we might be free.

All – our journey is towards being fully with God, raised to new life with Jesus. Leader – The cross is the sign of our freedom, it's a sign of our faith.

All – The cross is our hope, it's Jesus story and our story.

Leader – We are the people of the cross All – We tell the story of Jesus death and resurrection. Leader – We are the people of the cross **All – we live our lives in the shadow of the cross.**

Leader – We are the people of the cross. All – we are sheltered and protected by the cross of Jesus Christ.

The candidate is signed with the cross. Christ claims you for his own, receive the sign of the cross. Stand firm in the faith of Christ your Lord and Saviour.

All – do not be ashamed of the cross or of having faith in Jesus Christ. Live in the power of the cross and take the light of Christ into the dark places of the world.

Baptism

Leader – to enter God's kingdom you must be born again – born of water and the Spirit. Here is water for baptism.

All – Water can cleanse, heal, refresh, give life.

Leader – Father bless this water as it's used for baptism.

All – Bless Charles and Molly as they are baptized and fill them with you Holy Spirit. Leader – pour out upon Molly and Charles your love and grace that they may walk as children of light.

All – May your Holy Spirit cleanse, heal, refresh and give life, that Molly and Charles may walk as children of light.

I baptise you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, Amen. Leader – May God who has received you by baptism into His church, pour into your life His love and grace.

All – Live in the power of the cross, live in the light of truth, let the Holy Spirit guide your steps day by day.

A lighted candle is given

Leader – You have received the light of Christ, walk in the light all the days of you life **All – Shine as a light in the darkness of the world, to the glory of God the Father. Amen.**

Leader – By the Holy Spirit we are baptised and become one people

All - We welcome you into the church, Christ's body here on earth. We are children of the same heavenly father. We welcome you.
